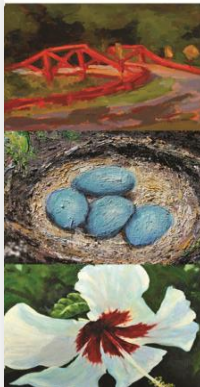

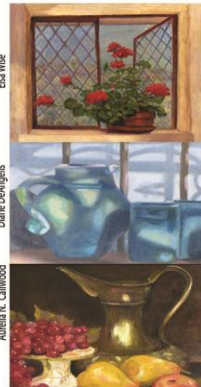

SEPTEMBER MEETING NEW WAVE PALETTE

It began in an art studio a decade ago. At the time, our father had been painting for over 40 years, and in the corner of his studio was a graveyard of sorts where old artist palettes were put to rest, none of which proved to be valuable enough for further use. Flo Schadler won First Place in the New Hope Art League Juried Art Show "Images of New Hope".

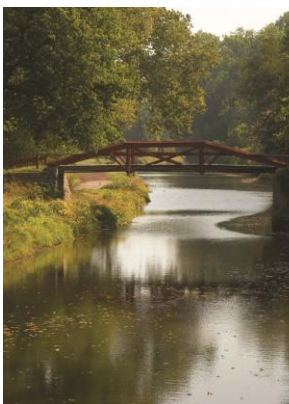
